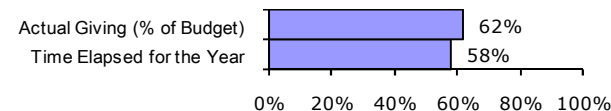

Missionary Moment - August 1, 2010

KEVIN LITCHFIELD serves as the area missionary for Cleveland, Ohio. His role is to serve and resource the local churches of the Greater Cleveland Baptist Association and plant new churches. Kevin's greatest desire is to see the city of Cleveland transformed for Christ by planting a strong, healthy church in all 21 wards of the city. Don is using his veterinary training to care for the Fulani's most prized possession, their animals. Neighborhood children are drawn to their house because of their children, Seth, Noah, and Abigail, their soccer ball, and their cold water. The Stelzers play Bible stories on cassette tapes for the children, and since they are still in language study, the cassettes have greatly aided their ability to share in the Fulani's heart language and show them how to "follow the way of Isaa". There are over 5,600 other international missionaries on the field who need our prayers and our faithful support through the Cooperative Program. Pray for the Stelzers as they serve the Lord and the people of West Africa.
